In the summer of 2004, Centrecourt launched the inaugural Hoopfest Tournament, created as an extension of the West Coast Basketball League, Centrecourt's flagship program, as a way to branch the fall and summer basketball season. While there have been and still are a number of outdoor summer basketball events, the void of a traditional indoor tournament was present and needed to be filled. Off and on for a number of years, the Lower Mainland had seen a few indoor summer tournaments take place, however they only lasted a short life span. Originally staffed by just three individuals for the first few years, the Hoopfest Tournament now welcomes a great opportunity for volunteer staff, many of which are students who are seeking to add experience to their resumes.

As the longest running indoor summer tournament in the Lower Mainland, the Hoopfest BC Tournament proudly offers teams an opportunity to use the event as a pre-season evaluation platform for many local university, college and professional teams and players. It is also an opportunity for sponsors and event supporters to connect with participants, many of which are connected throughout the province on a grassroots level.
